STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of Joshua Springs Christian School is to provide a sound, academic education based upon a firm foundation in the authoritative and inerrant Word of God. The school program is designed for children whose parents are committed to a personal faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

The Bible is specific in stating the principles which underline Christian education. The apostle Paul stated, "For by Him were all things created, that are in the Heaven, and that are in the earth...and He is before all things and by Him all things consist." (Colossians 1:16-17) The Gospel of John states, "All things were made through Him and without Him nothing was made that was made." (John 1:3)

Functioning as an extension of the Christian home, Joshua Springs Christian School supports parents who seek to obey the Biblical instruction, which gives them ultimate responsibility for the education of their children. This is taught in Deuteronomy, "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk to them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates." (Deuteronomy 6:6-9) Because the Christian approach to learning differs significantly from the secular viewpoint, Joshua Springs Christian School offers a curriculum rooted in a God-centered view of life. This view holds that God's truth is the standard for all truth. The curriculum, taught by a qualified Christian faculty, allows parents to provide their children with academic instruction consistent with the Christ-centered teaching received at home and at church.

As a Christian school, we can never forget or ignore our mission statement and the purpose of our existence. The Lord Jesus Christ has given us a commission and has entrusted His children into His care the honor of serving the living God. Let us seek Him in everything.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

Joshua Springs Christian School was founded and functions upon the basic fundamental principles of the Word of God, and espouses the historic Christian view of life as presented in the Bible. JSCS agrees with the Association of Christian Schools International seven-point "Affirmation of ACSI Statement of Faith". The following statements of faith and practice are held by every JSCS employee and school family. We believe:

1. The Bible to be the verbally inspired and the only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God.
2. There is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
3. In the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory.
4. That man is sinful by nature and that regeneration by the Holy Spirit is essential and an absolute necessity for his salvation.
5. In the continuing ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a Godly life.
6. In the resurrection of both the saved and the lost, they who are saved unto eternal life and they who are lost unto eternal damnation.
7. In the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.
8. In the creation of man by the direct act of God.

Joshua Springs Christian School is a religious institution providing an education in a distinct Christian environment, and it believes that its biblical role is to work in conjunction with the home to mold students to be Christ-like. We believe that God wonderfully and foreordained and immutably created each person as either male or female in conformity with their biologic sex. These two distinct yet complimentary genders together reflect the image and nature of God (Genesis 1:26-27). It is our policy, that on those occasions in which the atmosphere or conduct within a particular home and/or individual is counter to in opposition to the biblical lifestyle the school teaches, the school reserves the right, within its sole discretion, to refuse admission of an applicant or to discontinue enrollment of a student. This includes, but is not necessarily limited to, living in, condoning, or supporting sexual immorality; homosexual acts or sexual orientation; promoting such practices; or otherwise inability to support the moral principles of the school (Leviticus 20:13a, Romans 1:27, Matthew 19:4-6).

2023-2024 Tuition and Registration Fees

Application Fees:

A \$50.00 application fee is collected with every new student applying for admittance to JSCS. This is a **non-refundable** charge. Please review the basic requirements for applying.

Programs:

JSCS K-12 - Accredited, classroom-based learning, teacher-led instruction.

JSA K-12 – Joshua Springs Academy. Non-accredited, home-based learning, parent-led instruction, and curriculum.

Tuition:

Our payment plan makes tuition more manageable by allowing you the option to make 10 monthly payments starting in August and ending in May, 11 monthly payments starting in July and ending in May, or 12 monthly payments starting in August and ending in July. Tuition fees shall be refunded based on the JSCS Financial Contract Commitment.

The tuition price for the 2023-2024 JSCS K-12 program is:

***\$6950.00** (\$695.00 per month/10 payments; \$631.82 per month/11 payments)

Reservation Fees:

\$200 per child, reservation fee. This will hold your child(ren)'s place in their class. This reservation fee will be held until July 31st or until the tuition contract is complete, whichever is sooner, and is due at enrollment. The reservation fee will be applied to the 1st month's tuition. Should you decide not to enroll, the reservation fee is non-refundable.

TEXTBOOKS

Textbooks will be purchased directly by the parent from BJU Press. The book list will be provided by the school office. Options for e-text books (grades 4 and up) may be selected per parent discretion. E-textbook devices are recommended for numerous reasons including continuing updates, convenience, and weight of not carrying books. **The school will not be held responsible for loss, theft, damage, etc., for e-textbook devices, such as I-Pads or Chrome Books.**

The school yearbook is NOT covered and must be purchased separately.

***Joshua Springs Christian School contracts through FACTS Tuition Management Program for ALL tuition payments (unless you are paying in full in August). At time of enrollment, you will be given a financial contract to sign that will set up your payment plan with FACTS.**

\$450.00 (\$45.00 per month) per family, three (3) or more students

Annual Fees:

\$130 HSLDA (Home School Legal Defense Association) paid directly to HSLDA. Families must submit proof of annual membership **at time of registration.** (*HSLDA Group: JSA 299992*)

Book Fees:

Book fees vary based on parent selection of curriculum. Families pay directly to their publisher of choice. Christian-based curriculum is preferred.

DRESS CODE

Purpose and General Guidelines- more detailed information on dress code may be found in the student handbook.

This dress code applies to all school activities, on or off campus, wherever students represent Joshua Springs (sports events, school plays, awards banquets, graduation, etc.). The administration reserves the right to determine that which "attracts undue or excessive attention to the wearer..." and is therefore, unacceptable. The dress code is not all-inclusive; any situation not specifically covered herein will be resolved by the administration in accordance with the general intent and purpose of the code.

Tops:

- **Solid color** polo or button up shirt with a collar. No patterns.
- Joshua Springs Christian School branded T-shirts (JSCS/JSCC).
- The shirt must be in good condition i.e., not faded, no holes, no stains, not too big or too small. Clothes must be clean when worn to school.
- Tops must be long enough to cover the stomach when arms are raised above the head.
- Undergarments and cleavage should never be visible.
- Sleeveless tops, tank tops, tube tops, excessively tight tops, and spaghetti straps are prohibited, as are garments that are made of thin or clinging fabric.

Bottoms

- Uniform style shorts, cargo, walking shorts, jogger-style, and capris are acceptable.
- Shorts, jumpers, dresses, and skirts should be no shorter than mid-thigh. *Please make allowances for growth.*
- K-6 - Elementary students may wear khaki, navy, black or gray. Purchase from a uniform section of a retail store.
- 7-12 - Secondary students may wear khaki, navy, black, grey, olive, and brown. Purchase from a uniform section of a retail store.
- **Solid color** tights or leggings may be worn under skirts.
- Leggings may **not** be worn as pants.
- Girls may wear skorts, jumpers, and skirts **from the uniform section** of retail stores.
- Pants should not fit **excessively tight** and should not **fit** like leggings. Wear a longer top to cover the bottom completely if only tight in that area.
- **Jeans are NOT acceptable.**
- Students must wear their pants pulled up and undergarments should never be visible.
- Bottoms must be in good repair: no slits, tears, holes.
- No sweatpants or pajama pants. Sweatpants may be worn during PE class only.

Hair

- Hairstyles should be clean, neat, not in your face, and in an attractive manner. Avoid extreme or questionable hairstyles or colors.
- Students may dye their hair if the coloring is subtle and close to the student's natural color. (No greens, blues, pinks, purples, etc.)
- Unusual hairstyles that draw attention to the wearer are prohibited.
- Hair may not cover the eyes at any time. Boys with long hair below the neck line must pull their hair back in a hair tie.

Shoes

- Shoes or sandals must be worn at all times and sandals must have heel straps.
- To ensure safety when playing on the playground, elementary students should not wear shoes with heels.
- **Students are to wear sneakers on PE days.**

Accessories: (Jewelry/Piercings/Tattoos/Hats/Make-up)

- Girls may wear earrings and small nasal/nostril stud. Septum piercings are not allowed.
- Jewelry may be worn in moderation.
- Gauging, plugs, and sizers are not allowed.
- Boys may not wear any type of piercing.
- Tattoos are prohibited. Tattoos must be covered at all times.
- Hats may be worn by students outdoors, bill forward, at all times.
- Make-up may be worn as a part of the secondary girls' attire as long as it is worn in *moderation*.
- Chains, wallet chains, dog collars, studded belts, inappropriate belt buckles, spikes, etc. are prohibited.

The administration reserves the right to determine appropriate dress code.

Student Code of Conduct

Obedience, respect, and responsibility are key virtues that students must develop. Obedience to rules and guidelines is essential to the development of maturity (Luke 2:51, Hebrews 5:8). It results in genuine freedom in life (John 8:32). Respect is necessary for all successful and meaningful relationships (Luke 10:36–37, Romans 12:18) and the building of personal responsibility fosters a sense of achievement. Both responsibility and achievement are necessary ingredients to the development of self-worth (1 Corinthians 10:31, Ecclesiastes 9:10, Romans 14:12).

As we seek to provide a balanced and disciplined learning environment for the students of Joshua Springs Christian Schools, we realize that man's wisdom falls short of God's standards. We do not claim to be perfect in all our decisions, but we do try our best to discipline in a way that is biblical and pleasing to God. As partners in the discipline process, it is important that the school and the home work cooperatively for the students' good. Since we teach the students to obey and submit to their parents, it is imperative that parents maintain that continuity by upholding and teaching the principles taught at school. We can instill in students proper Christian educational and moral principles only through a program that includes clear disciplinary procedures, and as students and parents, your cooperation in that program is crucial. (Please be aware that the administration reserves the right to make discipline decisions on an individual basis.)

Our goal should always be to obey the Scripture that says, "And whatever you do, in word or in deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him" (Colossians 3:17, NKJV). In the best interest of the entire school community, certain guidelines of conduct must be maintained by all students of Joshua Springs Christian Schools, both on and off campus, so that we might all live and work happily together.

A Student Code of Conduct will be handed out at the beginning of the school year and will be required to be signed by each student in order to attend. **We expect students to represent our school and biblically based Christian moral and ethics 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year (24/7/365). Based on this policy, social media, outside school events, and personal lifestyle choices which are contrary to God's word or the schools' expectations could result in disciplinary action.**

Revised Board of Elders Position on Drug/Alcohol Use for Joshua Springs *Secondary* Students

The Board of Elders of Joshua Springs Calvary Chapel/Christian Schools believes that the school environment and all students and staff must be safe at all times. The Board further believes that students are not to be using marijuana, any other illegal drugs, and/or alcohol in accordance with the code of conduct of the school Student Manual which states:

Student use, possession, distribution, sale, or being under the influence of alcohol, illegal drugs, controlled substances, "look alike" drugs, steroids, or possessing drug paraphernalia on any school premise or at any school function (home or away) is strictly prohibited. Minimum penalty for violation of this policy may be suspension from school; however, violation of this policy could result in permanent expulsion from school.

To that end, the school has a zero tolerance of drug and/or alcohol use by students. If there is suspicion or notification that students are using drugs/alcohol, a drug test (urine) will be conducted. In addition, random drug tests will occur for **all secondary students**. If the test is positive for use, further action will include removal from a team/activity, suspension, and possibly expulsion. In addition, the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department may be notified. Students who test positive for drug use or are found in possession who are not expelled, will be placed on a behavior contract, which may include placement in the independent studies program (ISP), in order to remain at the school. This contract will have further stipulations.

MEDIATION AND BINDING ARBITRATION AGREEMENT

At Joshua Springs Christian Schools, we as Christians believe that the Bible commands us to make every effort to live at peace and resolve disputes with each other in private or within the Christian community in conformity with the biblical injunctions of I Corinthians 6:1-8, Matthew 5:23-24 and Matthew 18:15-20. Therefore, the parties (Joshua Springs Christian Schools and the parents or guardians of enrollees in Joshua Springs Christian Schools) agree that any claim or dispute arising out of, or related in any way to, any aspect of the relationship between Joshua Springs Christian Schools and its students and/or their families, including claim under federal, state, and local statutory or common law, the law of contract and law of tort, shall be settled by biblically based mediation, and, if necessary, binding arbitration.

If resolution of any dispute and reconciliation do not result from mediation, the matter shall then be submitted to an independent and objective arbitrator for binding arbitration. The parties agree for the mediation and arbitration process to be conducted in accordance with the "Rules of Procedure for Christian Conciliation" ("Rules") contained in the Peacemaker Ministries booklet, "Guidelines for Christian Conciliation". Consistent with these "Rules", each party to the agreement shall agree to the selection of the arbitrator. The parties agree that if there is an impasse in the selection of the arbitrator, the Institute for Christian Conciliation division of Peacemaker Ministries of Billings, Montana (406) 256-1583, shall have the power to select a Mediator and/or Arbitrator and its decision shall be final and binding on the Parties. The Mediator and/or Arbitrator shall be compensated based on the amount of time spent on the case at their regular hourly rates plus reimbursable out of pocket expenses. The Parties agree to share the cost of Mediation and/or Arbitration equally. Consistent with the "Rules", the arbitrator shall issue a written opinion within a reasonable time.

The parties to this contract agree that these methods shall be the *sole remedy* for any controversy or claim arising out of the relationship between Joshua Springs Christian Schools and its students and/or their families, and they *expressly waive* their right to file a lawsuit against one another in any civil court for such disputes, except to enforce a legally binding arbitration decision. The parties to this agreement have had an opportunity to consult legal counsel before signing this agreement.

Joshua Springs Christian School Financial Contract Commitment

The school's expenses are incurred on an **annual basis**. We are obligated to meet our expenses, including teacher's salaries, operational costs, etc., for the entirety of the school year. To satisfy this, while being aware that circumstances change, your financial obligation to the school will be for the **full quarter** of when you disenroll should this be necessary. This simply means that, should you choose to withdraw your child (ren) from JSCS, you will be responsible for the contracted payment through the current quarter of enrollment. Tuition remains the same, at \$6950.00, for the entire school year.

Responsibility for Tuition Fees: The undersigned parents or guardians shall be responsible for all tuition and fees for each academic quarter.

Tuition Obligation: The undersigned parents or guardians further agree that the parent's or guardian's decision to withdraw the students or the school dismissal of the student mid-year, whether as a result or accident, sickness, move or transfer, disciplinary action, academic failure, negative parent actions or otherwise, does not relieve the parent or guardian of the responsibility for payment of the entire quarter in which we are in.

Withdrawal: If a student withdraws during the 2023-2024 school year, you will be responsible for the remaining amounts:

August 28, 2023-October 27, 2023	\$1737.50
October 30, 2023-January 19, 2024	\$3475.00
January 22, 2024-March 22, 2024	\$5212.50
March 25, 2024-June 5, 2024	\$6950.00

For example, if you were to withdraw your child Sept. 30th, you will still be responsible for payment through the end of the first quarter, which ends October 27th. We would encourage anyone who withdraws to take into consideration quarter end dates, as it ensures a cleaner transition into your new school.

Many private schools have similar policies. We felt this was a necessary step for our school, as we want to be good stewards of God's resources and, especially, as we plan to staff our school adequately.

Conditions of enrollment: This contract is for the 2023-2024 academic year. In order for the school to reserve a place for your child for the 2023-24 academic year, a deposit of \$200 (per child) and signed enrollment contract (for each child) must be on file. The deposit of \$200 is non-refundable and is due when the application is received. This \$200 deposit will be applied to the first month's tuition. The reservation fee will be held until July 21, 2023; if no contract has been signed by that date, the student's reservation in that class is relinquished and the reservation fee forfeited.

Student Technology Use Agreement

Joshua Springs Christian School authorizes students to use technology owned or otherwise provided by the school as necessary for instructional purposes. JSCS reserves the right to suspend access at any time without notice for any reason.

JSCS expects all students to use technology responsibly in order to avoid potential problems and liability. JSCS may place reasonable restrictions on the sites, materials, and/or information that students may access through our WiFi system. Each student who is authorized to use technology and his/her parent/guardian shall sign this acceptable use agreement as an indication that they have read and understood the agreement. JSCS technology includes, but is not limited to, computers, the computer network server, and wireless computer networking technology, the Internet, emails, USB drives, wireless access points, tablets, Chromebooks, phones, wearable technology, and any wireless communication device including future technological innovations whether accessed on or off-site or personally owned equipment or devices.

The student in whose name the JSCS's technology is issued is responsible for its proper use at all times. 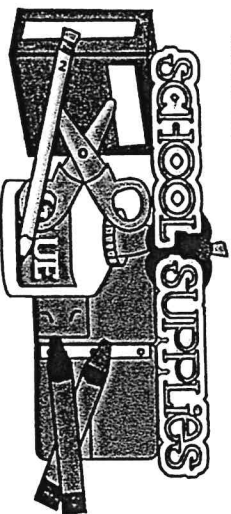

HEALTH EXAMINATION

Dear Parent(s) or Guardian:

We are glad you have chosen Joshua Springs Christian School for the 2023-2024 school year. As part of the enrollment process, the State of California Child Health Screening Law (H & SC 124100) requires that all children must have a health examination within the 18-month period prior to entering first grade or within 90 days after first grade entry.

The examination may be completed by taking your child to your private medical care provider for a physical examination. Please have the attached examination certificate completed and signed by the medical care provider, and return it to the school office **by August 1, 2023**. The purpose of the physical examination is to ensure good health for your child's growth and development and his/her ability to benefit from the school experience.

WHY YOUR CHILD NEEDS SHOTS:

The California School Immunization Law requires that children be up to date on their immunizations (shots) to attend school. Diseases like measles spread quickly, so children need to be protected before they enter. California schools are required to check immunization records for all new student admissions at Kindergarten or Transitional Kindergarten through 12th grade and all students advancing to 7th grade before entry.

THE LAW:

Health and Safety Code, Division 105, Part 2, Chapter 1, Sections 120325-120380; California Code of Regulations, Title 17, Division 1, Chapter 4, Subchapter 8, Sections 6000-6075

WHAT YOU WILL NEED FOR ADMISSION:

To attend school, your child's Immunization Record must show the date for each required shot above. If you do not have an Immunization Record, or your child has not received all required shots, call your doctor now for an appointment.

If a licensed physician determines a vaccine should not be given to your child because of medical reasons, submit a written statement from the physician for a **medical exemption** for the missing shot(s), including the duration of the medical exemption.

A personal beliefs exemption is no longer an option for entry into school; however, a valid personal beliefs exemption filed with a school before January 1, 2016 is valid until entry into the next grade span (7th through 12th grade). Valid personal beliefs exemptions may be transferred between schools in California. For complete details, visit ShotsForSchool.org.

You must also submit an immunization record for all required shots not exempted.
